### **About Napa Valley TV**

Napa Valley TV is YOUR Community Access TV station. You are invited to share our non-commercial TV station's broadcasting hours, television studio, video cameras, sound and lighting equipment. Services are available on a first come first serve basis. An annual membership at Napa Valley TV costs \$20 for individuals, \$30 for families, and \$70 for schools and other non-profit organizations. Members of Napa Valley TV may use our equipment for free.

### **How can I get my child or student's videos and films on TV?**

An adult pays the family membership fee (\$30) and takes the one-time Producer's Training (\$10) to learn the rights and responsibilities of television producers. Then your minor may put their videos/films on TV for free with your permission. If you are a teacher and would like to get your student's work on TV ask you school to become nonprofit member (\$70)

### **How can we get started using TV station equipment?**

After the Producer's Orientation and TV Production class you are ready to use and check out the equipment at Napa Valley TV. Minors must first be supervised by parents or guardians when using our equipment until it is clear that they do not need supervision in this manner.

Parents and guardians are legally responsible for minors' video content and for equipment they check out. Our equipment must be used to produce TV programs for our station.
